

FAIR PLAY PENALTIES

The following penalties will be in effect for the 2010 Ontario Cup Provincial Championships and Sanctioned Tournaments. These penalties are in accordance with Ontario Basketball's Fair Play Policy.

Player

Incident	Penalty
The player is ejected from the game.	That player is ineligible to compete in the next game.
<p>A player receives a flagrant foul and is ejected from the game for fighting.</p> <p>Fighting includes, but is not limited to combative acts such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. An attempt to strike an opponent with the fist, hands, arms, legs of feet. b. An attempt to punch or kick an opponent, regardless of whether contact is made. c. An attempt to instigate a fight by committing an unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent that causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting. 	That player is ineligible to compete for the remainder of the tournament.

Coach

Incident	Penalty
A coach is ejected from the game.	That coach is ineligible to coach in the next game.
<p>A coach receives a flagrant foul and is ejected from the game for fighting.</p> <p>Fighting includes, but is not limited to combative acts such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. An attempt to strike an opponent with the fist, hands, arms, legs of feet. b. An attempt to punch or kick an opponent, regardless of whether contact is made. c. An attempt to instigate a fight by committing an unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent that causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting. 	That coach is ineligible to compete for the remainder of the tournament.

Parent

Incident	Penalty
A parent is ejected from the gym for verbal or physical abuse of an official, player, coach, minor official or site supervisor or other spectator.	That parent will not be permitted in any Ontario Basketball facility for the remainder of the tournament.
